CTS electronics introduces new solutions at CeBIT 2010 for cheque scanning and cash management

CTS electronics celebrates its 30 years of technology introducing the new LS40 as best solution for RDC and small teller cheque scanning, plus innovative solutions for managing retail and self-banking cash transactions

***Ivrea (TO), Italy, february 4th, 2010:** CTS Electronics Spa, a world leading supplier of OEM products and solutions for the banking, retail and public administration market sectors, will be exhibiting at CeBIT 2010 in Hall 11, stand B54.*

CTS is proud to welcome you to its stand to witness its leadership and commitment to future growth. The new products and solutions introduced this year are of particular interest, starting with the **new LS40** scanner, characterized by its small size that fits every desktop space and the option to have the cheque passing through or return. It has several options, including an endorsement printer, badge reader, front personalization stamp, MICR reader, OCR and barcode recognition.

The new LS40 is addressed to Remote Deposit Capture (RDC) applications as well as small volume scanning at the bank teller.

Likewise the well known LS150 model is evolving in a product family. A new "Value Edition" will in fact be presented at CeBIT. The **new LS150-VE** shares the same mechanical structure, but has streamlined electronics and a simplified input feeder. At the "top of the family" you will see the **new LS150-UV**, the evolution that adds more security to cheque scanning through Ultra-Violet light document reading and security detection. A new **LS515** updated version will also be introduced.



Moreover, you will be able to see two new cash management solutions at our booth.

The first is named **RECASH**, a combined solution for the retail world. It is based on a BH engine (Banknote Handler) capable of accepting every € euro denomination which it counts, sorts and validates, and a 2 cassettes loader containing the two most common low-denomination banknotes for giving change. The unit can recycle the two low-denominations while the higher ones are stored on a removable metal strong box.

In the RECASH system the banknote handler is coupled with a CH engine (Coin Handler) to allow for mixed cash/coins payments. Since its primary use will be to give change, it contains 8 high capacity hoppers loaded with all the € euro denominations. Obviously the unit accepts coin payments, that will be recycled internally.

The other breakthrough is **FI2D**, which stands for Fast Intelligent Deposit and Dispensing. What is it about ? FI2D is a self-banking solution that allows users to deposit banknotes and cheques in bulk at an impressive speed. It is aimed to replace deposits made using envelops (as in night-drop deposits) and it will also have the option of dispensing banknotes. It can be used integrated in a Kiosk (as shown at our booth) or inside an ATM.
